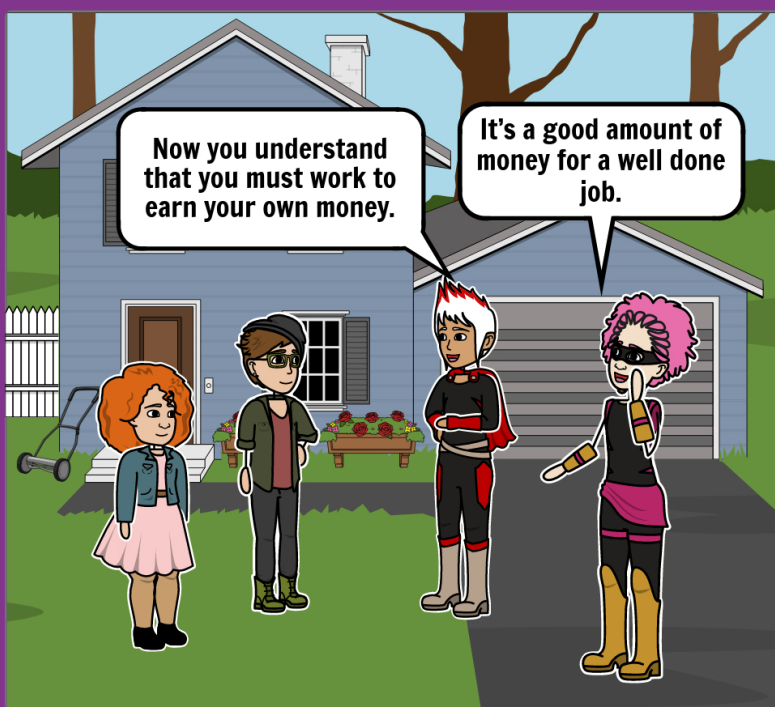

Tips for Parents

Get the whole family involved with just a few easy steps:

- **Demonstrate:** show and explain to children what you do at work so they understand why you are paid.
- **Provide opportunities:** Offer your children the possibility of doing household chores for common maintenance (pocket money). Give them tips on how to do the job well.
- **Develop understanding:** Encourage children to value the work done in the home.
- **Discuss:** Explain to children why work must be done well, and the importance of fair wages to reflect the work completed. Show them examples of poorly paid jobs or situations.

Involve children in doing community work at home. Participate beyond keeping their room clean and tidy.
